“It is so unfortunate that the conditions in downtown PG have deteriorated so dramatically that many residents fear spending time there,” stated Jess Ketchum, SOS co-founder. “Recent arsons have taken those fears to a new, understandable and unacceptable level. The provincial and federal governments must step up to support our communities by strengthening the judicial system and criminal code, filling police vacancies and support, and building out a full and comprehensive continuum of care for those suffering from addiction and mental illnesses, province wide.”
